Sector C

Sgt Puig: New Tampa

S-21 (Vehicle Burglary) #08-736996 Occurred at 16000 Westerham Dr (Sterling Manor, grid #233) between 12/6 at 1830 hrs and 12/7 at 0900 hrs. Victim left his 1999 Toyota Camry **UNLOCKED** and his wallet was stolen out of the center console. The wallet contained asst credit cards and a FL DL and (drum roll) no cash.
